



Passport® PCI-Upgrade Kit (v8.02) for Passports Shipped On or After October 1, 2008

Gilbarco®'s Passport POS (v8.02) is validated as meeting the Payment Card Industry (PCI) Security Standards Council's highest security standard, the Payment Applications Data Security Standard (PA-DSS).

It is time for BP, Concord (including Generics, Gulf, Sinclair, Sunoco, and Valero), Chevron, ExxonMobil, NBS/Cenex, and Shell retailers to schedule the upgrade to Version 8.02 software and the PA-DSS configuration.

Gilbarco will provide, **at no charge to you**, the components necessary to upgrade your Passport system to the PA-DSS configuration and will pay your Authorized Service Contractor (ASC) a fee towards the installation.

Your PA-DSS upgrade will include:

- > Enhanced Dispenser Hub (where required)
- > Firewall Router
- > PCI Upgrade Kit including cables and adapters
- > Version 8.02 software, documentation and licenses
- > PCI Implementation Guide
- > Additional components such as LAN Hub or USB/RS232 Converters where needed to accommodate your site requirements



What is involved?

Ask your Distributor for details regarding your site. Upgrade times vary by site, but average 6 hours for sites using current-production software. For approximately 6 hours, your site will be closed for sales while your technician:

- > Installs PA-DSS configuration components and cabling
- > Installs V8.02 software
- > Configures and tests your system
- > Prints your Passport Security Manager Report*

It will be your only means of access to secure areas of your Passport system with passwords only you know.
